Willow's End displays typical Sauvignon Blanc characteristic. Herbaceous and grassy on the nose, with tropical and gooseberry flavours on the palate.

Vinification:

Situated to the far north east of the South Island, Marlborough is New Zealand's largest wine making region. With a dry, sunny climate and cool evenings, it is the ideal area for the production of vibrant, crisp, fruity white wines. Sourced from a single vineyard in the central Wairau Valley of Marlborough, the Sauvignon Blanc grapes were destemmed, pressed and allowed to settle for 48 hours. The clear juice was then racked to stainless steel tanks and inoculated with carefully selected yeast strains.
